A. 3rd Street Project Re-grade Spillway- Bid & Contract

Discussion: Bid proposed by WEB construction to widen the right-of-way at the end of Ross and 3rd by an additional 20 feet and drop the grade another 2 feet in accordance with the engineer's specifications. Total bid \$10,100.

Motion by Council Member Jonathan Torres to approve the proposed bid and agreement with WEB construction to regrade the spillway into the creek. Seconded Mayor Pro Tem Mike Stephens. Vote 5-, motion carried.

B. Small Town Christmas Event




