A. Canvass of 2026 General Election- Resolution

From the canvas tabulations, there were a total of 333 total legal votes cast, and the candidates running for positions to fill the two (2) expiring alderman terms, and mayor term, in said election receiving the following votes:

**Alderman:**

Skyler Rainwater: 103 Votes

Rance Rasmussen: 20 Votes

Kenneth Eudy: 25 Votes

Jonathan P. Torres: 76 Votes

**Mayor:**

Steven M. Arens: 109 Votes

It is hereby declared that Skyler Rainwater to be elected to alderman seat #2 and Jonathan P. Torres to alderman seat #4 until their terms end in May of 2028. It is hereby declared that Steven M. Arens to the elected Mayor seat until his term ends in May of 2028.

Motion by Council Member Council Member Jonathan Torres to approve resolution, 10-26, accepting the 2026 general election canvas tabulations. Seconded by Council Member Megan Sheppard. Vote 4-0, motion carries.


