ORDINANCE # 16-25

AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF ROBERT LEE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2025 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 31, 2026; AND ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF ROBERT LEE FOR THE 2025-2026 FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROBERT LEE:

SECTION 1 That the appropriations for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025, and ending September 30, 2026, for the support of the general government of the City of Robert Lee, Texas, be fixed and determined for said terms in accordance with the expenditures shown in the City's fiscal year 2025-2026 budget, a copy of which is appended hereto as Exhibit A;

SECTION 2 That the budget, as summarized below and shown in words and figures in Exhibit A is hereby approved in all respects and adopted as the City's budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025, and ending September 30, 2026.
